The Dinner will take place on Saturday 3rd March 2018 at the Blackbourne Community centre at Elmswell, which for those of you who may not know is just off the A14 between Bury St Edmunds and Stowmarket. It's a nice modern venue with plenty of parking. The dinner will be a set three course meal that will include a vegetarian option that needs to be pre booked.

How to order tickets

Tickets at £26 each are available from the Guild Treasurer. Payment can be made by one of two methods.

The preferred method of payment is by internet banking to the Guild bank account, the alternative is payment by cheque.

When ordering tickets please be sure to indicate if you require the vegetarian option.

Tickets are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis

Please provide the account name of your sending account as it appears on your chequebook (this automatically shows up on the transaction in the bank statement) and provide full address details, including post code, so that the tickets can be posted to you.
