
**Suffolk Guild Inter District Challenge –

## **Paying money into the Guild Account**

With the current restrictions due to Covid-19, it is less likely that you will collect 'real' money anyway, but we would prefer you to pay any money collected into the Guild Account using internet banking please.

This may take a bit more co-ordination and it is important that you use an appropriate reference to ensure that the money is appropriated to the correct District! There is a restriction to the number of letters you can use but the following example would be ideal:-



- If you are running an event (virtual/real) ideally one person will collect the joining/entrance fee and then pay it in on behalf of the group
- Districts may have their own plans for keeping track of the money collected but it would be good if you could let your District Treasurer know that you have contributed
- Gift Aid – this is a tricky one! If you have registered for Gift Aid and you are making a personal contribution then Gift Aid can be claimed. If you are paying in money collected from others, you may not be able to claim Gift Aid unfortunately\*

Despite the current ringing restrictions, the Grant Aid work of the Guild goes on so do please support this competition either by arranging an event/activity or taking part in one. Don't forget that there will be an additional prize for the most innovative fund-raising idea too!

\* Gift Aid Small Donations Scheme. If a district runs an event and simply takes a collection for the fund, then provided it was all paid in cash and no more than £30 from one individual, the Guild can get the tax rebate.
